



# Adopt - A - Trail

The Hillside Beach Adopt-A-Trail is a volunteer based program where HBCA members maintain a path in the Hillside Beach area.

When a path is adopted, the adopter will commit to a two-year term in maintaining the path of their choice. With the two-year commitment, you have the ability to name the path for the term.

Once the path has been assessed and cleared, the adopter will perform basic maintenance every 2-3 weeks (including after high winds).



## **Basic maintenance will include the following (not limited to):**

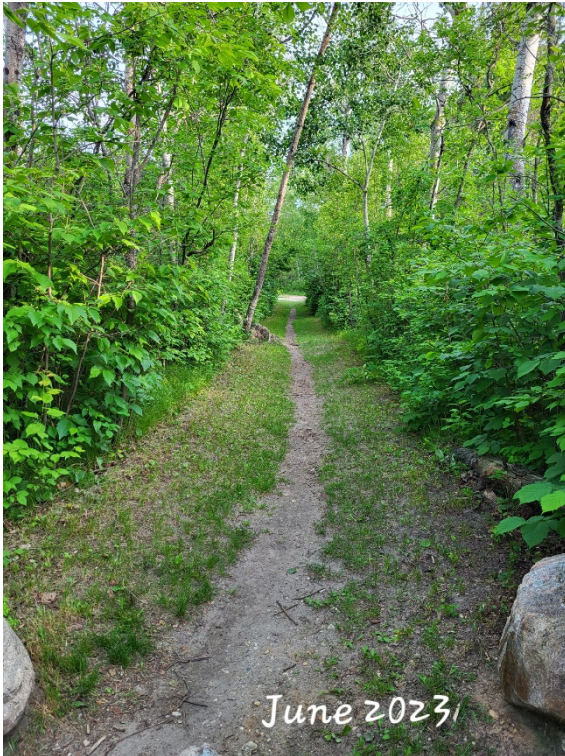
- Cutting grass
- Trimming of low hanging branches
- Trimming of grass around rocks and stumps
- Removing debris
- Contact HBCA of hazards

## **Basic Tools/Equipment will include the following (not limited to):**

- Lawn mower
- Weed Trimmer
- Hedge Clippers and/or Shears
- Protective gear
  - o Gloves
  - o Safety Glasses
  - o Hearing protection
- Rake
- Chain saw/Hand saw

*Important: When maintaining a path, please be cautious of poison ivy and hazards such as tripping and low hanging branches.*
